

## Transitioning to a New School---Medical Plans

### Prior to the PCS:

- If your child has a medical plan utilized at school (i.e.; Health Service Plan, Asthma Plan, Diabetes Plan etc....) contact your child's pediatrician and please review the plan. Discuss any changes that have occurred while implementing the plan to ensure changes are clearly outlined in the latest version.
  
- Contact your current SLO and EFMP manager to assist you in making contact with their counterparts at the new duty station. *\*Begin dialog to learn resources available.*
  
- Refill any medications and bring them with you.
  
- If your child is required to take medication while at school, please do the following:
  - ◆ Meet with the teacher and school nurse and provide them with the medication. Medications are typically kept in the school's clinic. *\*Please note: Medications are to be given as prescribed by the doctor.*
  
  - ◆ Please do not send in medication with your child.
  
  - ◆ Note on a home calendar or computer, one month prior to a medication expiration. If the medication expires (i.e.; inhaler), plan to fill the new prescription and bring it to your child's school to ensure medical needs can be met at all times.
