Domestic Violence Reporting Options



Restricted Reporting

Allows adult victims to **confidentially** report and receive services *without triggering an official investigation.*

To receive a Restricted Report, you **must only** report to the:

- Victim Advocate
- Victim Advocate Supervisor
- Health Care Provider

Unrestricted Reporting

Allows adult victims of abuse to report and receive services as *well as an official investigation.*

To receive an Unrestricted Report, you can report to the:

- Victim Advocate
- Law Enforcement
- Command
- Health Care Provider
