September 8 - 24, 2006

Agatha Christie's superlative comic mystery follows ten people struggling to survive a getaway on a secluded island. One unsuspecting victim suddenly drops dead ... poisoned. The accusations fly as one by one their number is decreased by some diabolical avenger. The excitement never lets up!

Children of Eden
November 3 - 19, 2006

From Stephen Schwartz (*Godspell* and *Pippin*) and John Caird (*Les Misérables*) comes a joyous and inspirational show about parents, children and faith. Freely based on the story of Genesis, this musical is a heartfelt and often humorous examination of the age-old conflict between parents and children. Adam, Eve, Noah and the "Father" who created them all must deal with the headstrong, cataclysmic actions of their respective children. The show delivers a bittersweet but inspiring message with a score that mixes pop, folk, rock, reggae, gospel and choral music.

Nunsense
February 23 - March 11, 2007

Dan Doggins' darkly humorous musical puts the Little Sisters of Hoboken into a fix. After 52 at the convent die in a tragic vichyssoise soup accident, the sisters discover that they have only enough money to bury 48 of the deceased sisters. The desperate nuns stage a fundraising talent show while the last four remaining bodies are put on ice in the convent freezer.

Carousel
May 11 - 27, 2007

The swaggering and carefree carnival barker, Billy Bigelow, captivates and marries the naïve millworker, Julie Jordan. The groom loses his job just as he learns the news that his new wife is expecting. Desperate to provide a decent life for his family, he becomes an accomplice to robbery. After being caught in the act, Billy takes his own life rather than face the certainty of prison. Billy is allowed to return to Earth for one day to instill a sense of hope and dignity in both his child and her mother. The score of this haunting Rodgers and Hammerstein musical features such classic songs as "June Is Bustin' Out All Over" and "You'll Never Walk Alone."
